

SUBJECT: Immediate Reenlistment Prohibition Codes (ERUP)

1. The below listed Immediate Reenlistment Prohibition Codes (ERUP) and priority precedence have been approved by the Army G1 and currently in RETAIN for use. Career Counselors will use these codes to identify soldiers with a disqualification.

2. Career Counselors are reminded to use the appropriate code based on the precedence. Establish precedence with the lowest number identifying the highest disqualification. Do not change ERUP codes having a higher precedence with one that has a lower precedence (i.e. changing a 9M, precedence 2 with a 9V, precedence 10). Use ERUP code "11" to identify soldiers who elect not take action to meet LCM commitment. See policy message 04-13 for further guidance for the use of ERUP code "11".
