SUBJECT: Medical Reclassification Processing

1. When Soldier is given a P3 Profile by a medical facility, they go to a MOS Medical Retention Board (MMRB). If the Board determines the Soldier is fit to remain on active duty, but in a different MOS a Medical Reclassification Action will be processed. **The PULHES are not the medical determination for the Soldier's MOS qualifications.** Refer to DA Pam 611-21, Chapter 9, paragraph 9-5b(2)(c). The Soldier's limitations in blocks 9, 10, and 11 of DA Form 3349 are the determination. Refer to Table 10 in DA Pam 611-21 for qualifications.
2. Process Medical Reclassification Actions IAW RECLASS Message 07-03 changing only the reclassification type to MRB2. When you are processing the eligibilities, you will use reclassification type MRB2 and the required documentation will be emailed to the RECLASS Team (efpr@conus.army.mil). The documents that are needed are the MMRBCA, the board proceedings, the profile and a copy of any waivers that may be required.
3. **When you are processing a medical reclassification action you want to look at shortage MOS first.** If there are none the Soldier is qualified for you can look at balanced MOS. **Over strength MOS's will not be considered, no exceptions.** The Soldier must meet all qualifications for the MOS including the medical limitations.
